

Nature of the Word

Concept:

We must all recognize that the Bible is God speaking to us. Hebrews 1:1-2 says that God has spoken to us through His Son. II Timothy 3:16 states that the written Word was “God breathed”. Jesus declares that His words are spirit and life. Psalms 89:34-35 tells us that God does not change His mind after He has spoken His Word. We must take God at His Word, because His Word is God.
